Categories may be combined depending on the number of entries in each category. In case of combined categories, awards will still be given based on the categories above. Relay will depend on the number of participants and will be announced on the competition day. Relay teams will be decided by the referee.

Entries

Deadline is Monday September 3rd 24:00 Click the "Trondheim Open"-link on the front page and complete the form for each athlete.

Entrance fee

Entry into the competition is NOK 400. We will email you an invoice.

Entry for recruits is free.

Places in the competition is limited and on a first come, first served basis. On Saturday evening there will be an informal banquet at a restaurant to be decided. The price for the banquet will be NOK 150-200 for food (to be paid individually at the restaurant).

Track

The competition will be held on a 60m x 30m artificial indoor ice surface with a 111.12 m oval track. Protective padding will cover the board in the turns (not the entire straightaways).

Conditions of contest

Seeding will be based on 500m time (SB or recent). The qualifying schedule is based on the "all final system". The organizers reserve the right to change the program due to any unforeseen circumstances.

Award of prizes

The award ceremony will be held after the competition on Sunday.

There will be cash prizes for the top finishers in the jr and sr categories based on the number of participants in the category.



Liability

All participants have to take care of their own safety. There will be medical personnel present throughout the competition. Please note that athletes must have hard knee protection (if possible knee/shin protection), short track helmet, cut-resistant gloves and cut-resistant neck-protection. Klapskates are not allowed.

At the same time participants should be covered by their own national insurance. The organizers cannot be held responsible for any kind of injury or property loss during the competition.

Accommodation and transport

The participating athletes are responsible for their own meals and accommodation.

We recommend Scandic Solsiden hotel for the participants. The hotel is centrally located in Trondheim, close to restaurants and shops and has a good standard.
